

Chaplain David Golden earned a Bachelor of Arts from Taylor College, a Masters of Divinity degree from Ansbury Theological Seminary, and a Master of Theology degree from Princeton Theological Seminary. Chaplain Golden was an active duty U.S. Army chaplain from 1970-1999 and retired with the rank of Colonel. Chaplain Golden served in Vietnam as the 1st Armored Division chaplain.
